US-Poland Innovation HUB, "Innovation HUB" in short, is an acceleration program aimed at supporting Polish innovative companies in their expansion on the global markets. During a series of training sessions, the program participants are prepared for business meetings and negotiations with partners and investors in Silicon Valley.

THE HUB - WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

The program focuses on managers and leaders of Polish companies which intend to expand globally and:

- · plan to enter the U.S. market
- are looking for partners and/or investors in the U.S. market
- plan to set up an office or business representation in Silicon Valley
- represent industries, which have high growth potential in Silicon Valley (IT, high-tech, clean-tech, bio-tech, etc.)

US-POLAND INNOVATION HUB – THE PROGRAM

The **1st PART** of the program takes place in Poland and includes training sessions, workshops and individual mentoring hours with the HUB experts from the United States.

- Best practices in global business
- Strategy Execution Map & Business Model Canvas
- Elevator Pitch
- · Protection of Intellectual Property Rights
- Marketing strategies on global markets
- Investor Mentoring, negotiations with investors
- · Design Thinking
- Cooperation between academia and industry
- Networking
- Office Space/Office Address in Silicon Valley (business representation)
